2017 Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement

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## Executive Summary

Students enter the Oklahoma State University (OSU) campus with a variety of backgrounds and experiences that relate to their academic engagement and success. The Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement (BCSSE) is designed to collect data regarding entering college students' high school academic and co-curricular experiences as well as their expectations for participating in educationally purposeful activities during their first year of college. The purpose of BCSSE is to provide OSU with valuable and timely information that will to positively impact first-year experiences of students The BCSSE was administered at OSU during late Summer 2017. Previously BCSSE was administrated at OSU during academic years of 2011 and 2014. Below is a brief summary of key findings from this year's survey.

## Key Findings

A total of 1,104 responses were received from incoming freshmen who were planning on matriculating at Oklahoma State University in August of 2017, yielding a response rate of $25.2 \%$. In four main themes OSU students scored above average:

- OSU students expected to engage in discussions with diverse others often.
- OSU students expected they would certainly persist in the face of academic adversity.
- OSU students perceived they are prepared for academic challenges, especially students who are Non First-Generation or scored A- or higher in high school.
- A challenging and supportive campus environment is important for OSU students, especially for students who scored A- or higher in high school.


## Overview of the Survey

The 2017 Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement (BCSSE) asks incoming freshmen questions about their high school experiences and expectations for college. Many of the questions parallel items that are included on the National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE), which was administered at Oklahoma State University in Spring 2018. The main objective of the BCSSE is to better understand students' high school experiences and expectations for the college experience. In addition, we hope to match many of these questions with responses on the National Survey of Student Engagement (administered in Spring 2018) so students' expectations for college and their actual level of engagement once they arrive on campus can be compared.

## Response Rate

An invitation to participate in the BCSSE was administered via email to 4,377 new freshmen who were planning on matriculating at Oklahoma State University in August 2017. The invitation was timed to be distributed after students had attended New Student Orientation, but prior to students' arrival on campus. A total of 1,104 responses were received for a response rate of $25.2 \%$. Compared to OSU's 2014 BCSSE administration of the survey (response rate of 28.0\%), a slightly lower response rate was achieved. Demographic characteristics of respondents are summarized in the table on the next page.

## Instrument Design

The instrument was designed and is coordinated by Indiana University Center for Post-Secondary Research and Planning. The BCSSE is a 34 -item questionnaire which contains nine scales. The scales include Quantitative Reasoning, Learning Strategies, Collaborative Learning, Student-Faculty Interaction, Expected Discussions with Diverse Others, Expected Academic Perseverance, Expected Academic Difficulty, Perceived Academic Preparation, and Importance of Campus Environment. ## Demographic Information

Total number of participants in BCSSE survey was $1,104(N=1,104)$

## Gender

- $65.37 \%$ of participants were Female $(n=606)$
- $33.87 \%$ of participants were Male $(n=314)$
- $0.32 \%$ of participants were from another gender identity $(n=3)$
- $0.43 \%$ of participants preferred not to answer gender question $(n=4)$


## Race/Ethnicity

- $3.56 \%$ of participants were American Indian or Alaskan Native ( $n=33$ )
- $2.59 \%$ of participants were Asian $(n=24)$
- $4.64 \%$ of participants were Black or African American $(n=43)$
- $3.13 \%$ of participants were Hispanic or Latino ( $n=29$ )
- $0.32 \%$ of participants were Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander $(n=3)$
- $69.33 \%$ of participants were White $(n=642)$
- $0.11 \%$ of participants were from Other racial groups ( $n=1$ )
- $15.44 \%$ of participants were Biracial or Multiracial ( $n=143$ )
- $0.86 \%$ of participants preferred not to answer the race question $(n=8)$


## High School Graduation Year

- $0.09 \%$ of participants were graduated from high school in $2014(n=1)$
- $0.18 \%$ of participants were graduated from high school in $2015(n=2)$
- $1.09 \%$ of participants were graduated from high school in $2016(n=12)$
- $98.63 \%$ of participants were graduated from high school in 2017 ( $n=1081$ )


## First Generation Status

- $39.81 \%$ of participants were First-Generation students ( $n=369$ )
- $60.19 \%$ of participants were Non First-Generation students ( $n=558$ )


## International or Foreign National Student

- $0.86 \%$ of participants were International students $(n=8)$
- $99.14 \%$ of participants were Domestic students $(n=918)$


## Results

BCSSE Scale scores were calculated by converting the responses for each item to a $0-60$ range so that comparison among components could be possible. A mean scale score was then calculated for each student. Below is a brief description of each scale with the component BCSSE items.

- Quantitative Reasoning measures student engagement with analysis and numerical information on a scale from Never $=\mathbf{0}$ to Very Often $=\mathbf{6 0}$; OSU students scored an average of 28.21 which indicates they engaged quantitative reasoning sometimes.
- Learning Strategies measures students' use of effective learning strategies on a scale from Never $=\mathbf{0}$ to Very Often $=\mathbf{6 0}$; OSU students scored an average of 36.01 which indicates they used effective learning strategies often. In addition, there is a significant difference in learning strategies between students who scored an $A$ - or higher in high school $(M=36.49)$ and students who scored a $\mathrm{B}+$ or lower in high school ( $\mathrm{M}=34.54$ ).
- Collaborative Learning measures students' expectation to interact and collaborate with peers on a scale from Never $=\mathbf{0}$ to Very Often $=\mathbf{6 0}$; OSU students scored an average of 37.96 which indicates they expected to interact and collaborate with peers often.
- Student-Faculty Interaction measures students' expectation to interact and engage with faculty on a scale from Never $=\mathbf{0}$ to Very Often = 60; OSU students scored an average of 33.28 which indicates they expected to interact and engage with faculty often.
- Expected Discussions with Diverse Others measures students' expectation to engage in discussions with diverse others on a scale from Never $=\mathbf{0}$ to Very Often = 60; OSU students scored an average of 43.52 which indicates they expected to engage in discussions with diverse others often.
- Expected Academic Perseverance measures students' certainty that they will persist in the face of academic adversity on a scale from Never at all certain $=0$ to Very Certain=60; OSU students scored an average of 43.07 which indicates they will certainly persist in the face of academic adversity.
- Expected Academic Difficulty measures students' expected academic difficulty during the first year of college on a scale from Never at all Difficult $=0$ to Very Difficult= 60; OSU students scored an average of 29.33 which indicates a medium level of difficulty. In addition, results show that there is a significant difference in expected academic difficulty between First- Generation students ( $\mathrm{M}=30.23$ ) and Non First-Generation students ( $\mathrm{M}=28.81$ ).
- Perceived Academic Preparation measures students' perception of their academic preparation on a scale from Not at all Prepared = 0 to Very Prepared = 60; OSU students scored an average of 43.23 which indicates they perceived they are prepared for academic challenges. In addition, results show there is a significant difference in perceived academic preparation between First- Generation students $(M=41.87)$ and Non First-Generation students $(M=44.17)$ and between students who scored an A- or higher in high school $(M=43.69)$ and students who scored a $B+$ or lower in high school $(M=41.69)$.
- Importance of Campus Environment measures students' level of importance that the institution provides a challenging and supportive environment on a scale of Not Important $=\mathbf{0}$ to Very Important $=\mathbf{6 0}$; OSU students scored an average of 46.08 which indicates a challenging and supportive environment is important to them. In addition, results show there is a significant difference in importance of campus environment between students who scored an A - or higher in high school $(M=46.44)$ and students who scored a $B+$ or lower in high school $(M=44.99)$.
