2011 Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement

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## Overview

The 2011 Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement asks incoming freshmen questions about their high school experiences and expectations for college. Many of the questions parallel items that are included on the National Survey of Student Engagement, a survey in which Oklahoma State University will be participating in the spring of 2012.

The purpose of this survey is to better understand students' high school experiences and expectations for the college experience. In addition, we hope to match many of these questions with responses on the National Survey of Student Engagement so we can compare students' expectations for college with their actual level of engagement once they arrive on campus.

### *Response Rate*

An invitation to participate in this survey was sent through email at the end of July, 2011 to 3,734 new freshmen who were planning on matriculating at Oklahoma State University in August of 2011. The invitation was timed to be after students had attended New Student Orientation but prior to students' arrival on campus. A total of 742 responses were received for a response rate of 20%. Although this response rate is fairly low, it is similar to the response rate Oklahoma State University received on the 2009 National Survey of Student Engagement. The demographic characteristics of respondents are summarized in the table on the next page.

### *Instrument Design*

The instrument was designed by the National Survey of Student Engagement. Additional details about the survey can be obtained by visiting the BCSSE website, at <http://bcsse.iub.edu>.

### *Understanding Results*

Results for each survey question below are presented in two ways. First, the raw, unweighted results (as received in the survey) are presented in the first six columns. Examination of the demographic data of respondents made it clear that respondents were not similar to Oklahoma State's student population in representing the proportion of males and females in the incoming freshman class. As a result, results were weighted to accurately reflect the proportion of males and females. Those results are presented in the last six columns.
