**2001 OSU Survey of Alumni of Graduate Programs**

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## **Executive Summary**

The 2001 OSU Survey of Alumni of Graduate Programs was conducted to identify institutional strengths and areas for improvement as indicated by graduates; to track the career and continuing education trends of OSU graduates; to assess achievement of learning outcomes as perceived by alumni from individual graduate academic programs; and to accomplish the State Regent's mandate for assessing student and alumni satisfaction. The survey was conducted in January and February 2001 and targeted alumni of graduate programs who completed their degrees in calendar years 1995 and 1999. Only alumni from academic departments or colleges that elected to participate in the survey were included in the target population; this included the entire College of Business Administration, the entire College of Education, the entire College of Human Environmental Sciences, sixteen departments in the College of Arts and Sciences, eight departments in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources, five departments in the College of Engineering, Architecture, and Technology, and one interdisciplinary program. The survey was administered as a telephone interview and included common questions (related to employment and continuing education) and questions related to program outcomes for each degree program.

- *Response Rate.* Out of an initial target population of 1,835, 677 telephone interviews with OSU graduate program alumni were completed, resulting in a response rate of 37%. When adjusted for alumni for whom a telephone number could not be determined and alumni who could not be reached in the U.S., the response rate to the survey was 66%.
- *Residency.* An estimated 65% of the alumni who participated in the survey were living in Oklahoma, and 35% were contacted out-of-state. Because the survey did not attempt to reach alumni who were not in the U.S., the number of alumni who no longer live in Oklahoma may be underestimated.
- *Employment.* Almost 90% of alumni reported that they were employed. Most alumni reported working for educational institutions or organizations (44%); 26% were employed by large corporations, and 12% were employed by small businesses or corporations. Alumni most frequently reported that their annual salary was in the range of \$35,001 to \$45,000 per year. Approximately 83% of employed alumni reported that they were very satisfied/satisfied that their OSU education had prepared them for their current position.
- *Continuing Education.* Eleven percent of alumni were enrolled in graduate programs or professional schools. Fifty-five percent of these were enrolled in OSU graduate programs. Eighty-one percent were pursuing doctoral degrees and 11% were pursuing master's degrees. Seventy-seven percent of alumni who were attending graduate or professional school stated that they were very satisfied/satisfied that their OSU education had prepared them for their continued education.
- *Overall Satisfaction.* Over 96% of alumni reported that they were very satisfied or somewhat satisfied with their overall educational experience at OSU.



## **Introduction**

In a comprehensive assessment effort, many voices within an institution are necessary to gain a thorough understanding of the effectiveness of the curricula. Because the focus of assessment is on helping improve the preparation of graduates, one approach to addressing questions about preparation for the workplace is to ask graduates themselves (Palomba & Banta, 1999)<sup>1</sup>. Alumni provide a logical source of feedback and a unique perspective on the application of curricula in practice.

Information from alumni also plays an important role in the process of academic assessment. Higher education in the United States has been undergoing critical scrutiny in the 1990s whereby parents, students, and government leaders alike are increasingly calling into question the value of a college degree. This scrutiny is fueled by the well-documented escalation of the costs of college attendance over the past two decades and concerns about the employment prospects and even the employability of college graduates (McGuire & Casey, 1999)<sup>2</sup>. Against this backdrop, the pressure on colleges and universities to maximize and demonstrate effectiveness is at an all-time high. Because a college education is a lifelong investment with presumed dividends accruing for many years after graduation, it is logical to seek out answers to the public's legitimate concerns through alumni surveys. Data from alumni surveys can be a valuable part of assessment efforts aimed at providing public accountability as well as evaluative information that can be used for program improvement.

The Oklahoma State University survey of alumni of graduate programs conducted in January and February 2001 sought, among other things, to identify the extent to which alumni of graduate programs were satisfied that they had received a quality graduate education at OSU. The survey provided data (1) to track alumni career trends; (2) to assess alumni satisfaction with their graduate program experiences at OSU; and, (3) to assess graduate program outcomes.

## **Methods**

*Population.* The target population for this survey was OSU graduate degree recipients who graduated in 1995 and 1999. Only alumni from departments and colleges that elected to participate in the alumni survey were included in the target population (Table 1). This included the entire College of Business Administration, the entire College of Education, the entire College of Human Environmental Sciences, sixteen departments in the College of Arts and Sciences, eight departments in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources, five departments in the College of Engineering, Architecture, and Technology, and one interdisciplinary program. The total number of OSU alumni of graduate programs in the target population was 1,835.

*Instrument Design.* The Assessment Council and the individual academic departments that participated in the survey developed the survey instrument. The first part of the survey (Common Questions) was developed by the Assessment Council and was given to all alumni. It included questions on current employment, continuing education, and general satisfaction. The second part of the survey was developed by each participating academic unit and was only given to alumni of that unit. This part of the survey focused on specific aspects of the alumnus' degree program and career preparation.

*Survey Administration.* The survey was administered as a telephone interview. The OSU Bureau for Social Research conducted the survey telephone interviews in January and February 2001 and coordinated data collection. The Office of University Assessment coordinated (a) the development of the survey instruments, (b) efforts to obtain accurate alumni telephone numbers, (c) data analysis, and (d) report preparation. The Office of Institutional Research provided alumni telephone numbers.

## **Results**

*Response Rate.* A total of 677 alumni telephone interviews were completed, resulting in an overall response rate of 37% (Table 1). Out of the initial target population of 1,835 alumni, 813 alumni could not be reached because the number was deemed 'unreachable' (i.e., wrong number, disconnected, cell phone, no phone or not qualified), the number was a callback, the number led to an answering machine, there was a language barrier, the line was busy, there was no answer, the number was a fax line, or the alumnus' refusal to complete the survey. After accounting for these 'unreachable' alumni, the overall adjusted response rate was 66% (Table 1).

Out of the total population of survey respondents, 32% were alumni from the College of Education, 22% were alumni from the College of Arts & Sciences, 18% were alumni from the College of Business Administration, 11% were alumni from the College of Engineering, 9% were alumni from the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources, 7% were alumni from the College of Human Environmental Sciences, and 2% were from interdisciplinary degree programs.

### *Current Employment Information*

Almost 90% of alumni (n=677) reported that they were employed or simultaneously employed and in graduate/professional school. Of these, 93% were employed full-time. Of the 34 alumni (5%) who reported they were not currently employed or in graduate or professional school, only six said that they were currently seeking employment.

Approximately 44% of alumni survey participants described their employer as an educational institution or organization; 26% were employed by large corporations; and, 12% were employed by a small business or corporation. Table 3 summarizes the names of alumni employers and job titles.

About 85% of alumni reported that their current position was highly or moderately related to their graduate studies, and 8% reported that their current position was slightly related to their studies. The most frequently reported annual salary range for alumni was \$35,001 to \$45,000 per year. Almost 50% of alumni reported annual salaries of greater than \$45,000 per year, and less than 23% of alumni reported annual salaries of less than \$35,000 per year.

In general, 83% of alumni responded that they were very satisfied/satisfied that their graduate studies prepared them for their current position.

### *Graduate/Professional School Information*

Of the 677 alumni surveyed, 74 (11%) were currently enrolled in a graduate or professional school. Of these alumni, 81% were pursuing doctoral (PhD) degrees, 11% were pursuing a masters degree, 5% were pursuing an unspecified graduate degree, and 3% were pursuing business degrees. Of the 74 alumni who were attending graduate school, 55% (n=41) were enrolled in graduate programs at Oklahoma State University, and 12% were attending graduate schools at other Oklahoma institutions (Table 4). Seventy-seven percent of these alumni

stated that they were very satisfied/satisfied that their graduate studies at OSU had prepared them for graduate or professional school.

*Resident Information (In-State / Out-of-State)*

Approximately 65% of the alumni who participated in the survey were living in Oklahoma, and 35% were contacted out-of-state (Table 5). These percentages come from zip codes provided by respondents. Because the survey did not attempt to reach alumni who were not in the U.S., the percentage of alumni who live outside of Oklahoma may be underestimated.

*Alumni Perceptions of Overall Educational Experience*

Alumni who participated in this survey expressed high overall satisfaction with their educational experience at OSU. Over 96% of alumni responded that they were very satisfied or somewhat satisfied with their overall educational experience.

Alumni were given the opportunity to make additional comments about their experiences as graduate students at OSU. Individual responses are listed in the Appendix.

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This report summarizes data from the Common Questions that were given to all alumni. Alumni were also given a set of questions that were developed by the academic program from which they received their degree. Results of program-specific survey questions are summarized in separate reports prepared for each participating academic unit.
