2012 Survey of Alumni of Undergraduate Programs

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Overview

Response Rate

Two thousand four hundred nine alumni responded to the survey from the target population of 7,449 undergraduate alumni who graduated either in 2006 or 2010 for an absolute response rate of 32.3%. After removing alumni who had invalid telephone numbers, the overall adjusted response rate was 54.5%.

Residency

Two thousand two hundred forty-nine alumni provided information about their current residence location. Of these respondents, about 71% resided in Oklahoma, while 18% resided in surrounding states (Texas, Kansas, Colorado, Missouri, Arkansas, and New Mexico).

Employment

84.9% (n = 2071) of responding alumni were currently employed. Only 4% of respondents were currently seeking employment¹. In March of 2012, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the state of Oklahoma was 5.4% (Bureau of Labor Statistics). Of the employed alumni, 88.2% were employed full-time. 34.4% of those who were employed were employed by large corporations, 23.5% were employed in a small business or small corporation, and educational institutions employed 21.9%. The remaining alumni reported employment with the federal government, state government, local government, nonprofit organizations, or were self-employed. About 67% of alumni reported their current position was either moderately or highly related to their degree. Nearly 91% of alumni reported their undergraduate degree prepared them adequately or very well for their current position.

Salary

The most frequently reported annual salary range for alumni who graduated both one and five years ago and were employed full time was \$25,000 or greater but less than \$35,000 (18.8% of alumni reported this income range). 52.2% of respondents who were employed full time reported salaries of \$45,000 or greater. 28.7% of respondents who were employed full time reported salaries of \$35,000 or less and 16% reported salaries of \$65,000 or greater. In comparison, the average annual wage in Oklahoma in May of 2011 was \$38,190 (Bureau of Labor Statistics).

Continuing Education

35% of survey respondents reported they were either currently enrolled in another degree program or had already completed a subsequent degree beyond the bachelor's degree earned at OSU. Most of these respondents indicated they had either completed or were in the process of completing a Master's degree (60%), followed by medical (9%) and business degrees (9%). 92% of these alumni reported their undergraduate degree had prepared them very well or adequately for their graduate/professional degree program.

Overall Satisfaction

89% of respondents were satisfied or very satisfied with the quality of instruction at Oklahoma State University. About 69% were satisfied or very satisfied with academic advising and a little more than 90% reported that they were either satisfied or very satisfied with their overall educational experience at Oklahoma State University.



Methods

The target population for this survey included everyone who received an undergraduate degree from OSU in 2006 or 2010. The response rates for individual degree programs are shown below. The total number of alumni in the target population was 7,449. The survey was conducted from January to June of 2012; therefore alumni were contacted approximately one and five years after graduating from OSU.

Instrument Design

The Assessment and Academic Improvement Council and the individual academic departments that participated in the survey developed the survey instrument. The first part of the survey, called the 'common questions,' was given to all alumni. It included questions on current employment, continuing education, and overall satisfaction. The second part of the survey was developed by each participating department and was only given to alumni from that department. This part of the survey focused on specific aspects of alumni's degree programs. If an alumnus' degree program did not provide program-specific questions, he or she was asked 8 general questions developed by the Office of University Assessment and Testing. These questions focused upon the perceived satisfaction, effectiveness, strengths, weaknesses, and quality of his or her OSU experience. This report summarizes alumni's responses to the common questions. Separate reports are prepared for each department outlining the survey responses for their alumni.

Survey Administration

The survey was administered online and through telephone interviews. The office of University Assessment and Testing (UAT) sent three rounds of survey emails in January and conducted telephone interviews from February through May 2012. The final email reminder was sent in May and the survey administration closed in June. The office of Institutional Research and Information Management provided alumni's email addresses and telephone numbers. The Office of University Assessment and Testing coordinated the development of the survey instrument, conducted data collection and analysis, and prepared the reports.



Results

This section summarizes results from the 2012 Survey of Alumni of Undergraduate Programs for the common questions. Results of department-specific survey questions were summarized in separate reports prepared for each participating department. The department-specific reports were sent to each department and are made publicly available on the University Assessment and Testing website (<http://uat.okstate.edu>).

Response Rate

A total of 2,409 participants responded from the target population of 7,449 alumni who graduated in either 2006 or 2010 for an overall response rate of 32.3%. Response rates for each college and degree program are summarized in Table 1. An adjusted response rate was calculated to examine the response rate when excluding those alumni who were deemed “unreachable².” When accounting for ‘unreachable’ alumni the overall adjusted response rate was 54.5%.

² An alumnus was deemed “unreachable” if there were no valid phone numbers. We had no way to determine whether or not email messages were received.

Current Employment Information

84.9% (n = 2071) of respondents indicated they were currently employed (CQ1). 4.3% of respondents were seeking employment. Of employed alumni, 88.2% were employed full-time (CQ4). 34.4% were employed by large corporations, 23.5% were employed with a small business or small corporation, 21.9% were employed by educational institutions, 4.7% were employed by the federal government, 4.7% were employed by nonprofit organizations, and 3.7% were self-employed. 3.1% of respondents were employed by state government and local government (CQ3) employed 2.2%.

The most frequently reported annual salary range across one and five years post-graduation was at least \$25,000 but less than \$35,000 with 18.8% of alumni reporting this salary range. About 9.8% of alumni reported an annual salary ranging from \$75,000 to \$100,000 while 4.2% reported an annual salary of more than \$100,000 (CQ7). About 67% of alumni indicated their current position was either moderately or highly related to their degree. Nearly 91% of alumni reported that their undergraduate degree prepared them adequately or very well for their current position.



Continuing Education and Graduate / Professional School Information

35% of survey respondents reported they were either currently enrolled in another degree program or had already completed a subsequent degree after graduating from OSU (CQ8). Most of these respondents indicated they had either completed or were in the process of completing a Master's degree (60%), followed by medical (9%) and business degrees (9%). About 2% of respondents either had completed or were currently enrolled in a doctoral program (CQ9).

Of those who completed or were currently enrolled in a graduate/professional degree program, over 65% attended an institution within the state of Oklahoma. Of those who provided an institution name for their graduate/professional degree program, 50% had enrolled in a graduate/professional degree program at Oklahoma State University.

About 52% of these respondents reported that their undergraduate degree prepared them very well for continuing their education, while nearly 40% indicated that they were adequately prepared for their subsequent degree program.
