2014 Survey of Alumni of Undergraduate Programs

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Overview

Response Rate

3,149 alumni responded to the survey from the target population of 7,473 undergraduate alumni who graduated either in 2008 or 2012 for an absolute response rate of 42.1%. After removing alumni who had invalid telephone numbers, the overall adjusted response rate was 56.2%.

Residency

2,866 alumni provided information about their current residence location. Of these respondents, about 67% resided in Oklahoma, while 21% resided in surrounding states (Texas, Kansas, Colorado, Missouri, Arkansas, and New Mexico).

Employment

87.3% (n = 2709) of responding alumni were currently employed. Only 3.5% of the total respondents were currently seeking employment¹. In June of 2014, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the state of Oklahoma was 4.5% (Bureau of Labor Statistics², 2014). Of the employed alumni, 91.5% were employed full-time. 36.5% of those who were employed were employed by large corporations, 25.7% were employed in a small business or small corporation, and educational institutions employed 18.7%. The remaining alumni reported employment with the federal government, state government, local government, nonprofit organizations, or were self-employed. About 68.7% of alumni reported their current position was either moderately or highly related to their degree. 92.5% of alumni reported their undergraduate degree prepared them adequately or very well for their current position.

Salary

The most frequently reported annual salary range for alumni who graduated both one and five years ago and were employed full time was \$45,000 but less than \$55,000 (17.5% of alumni reported this income range). Over half of all survey respondents (53.6%) who were employed full time reported salaries of \$45,000 or greater. 21.3% of respondents who were employed full time reported salaries of \$35,000 or less and 27.3% reported salaries of \$65,000 or greater. In comparison, the average annual wage in Oklahoma in 2013 was \$40,122.65 (Oklahoma Employment Security Commission³, 2014).

Continuing Education

32.9% of survey respondents reported they were either currently enrolled in another degree program or had already completed a subsequent degree beyond the bachelor's degree earned at OSU. Most of these respondents indicated they had either completed or were in the process of completing a Master's degree (60.4%), followed by medical (9.4%) and business degrees (7.9%). 92.5% of these alumni reported their undergraduate degree had prepared them very well or adequately for their graduate/professional degree program.

Overall Satisfaction

90% of respondents were satisfied or very satisfied with the quality of instruction at Oklahoma State University. 70.2% were satisfied or very satisfied with academic advising and a little more than 75% reported that they were either satisfied or very satisfied with their overall educational experience at Oklahoma State University.

Methods

The target population for this survey included everyone who received an undergraduate degree from OSU in 2008 or 2012; therefore alumni were contacted approximately one and five years after graduating from OSU. The survey was conducted from January to June of 2014. The total number of alumni in the target population was 7,487. The response rates for individual degree programs are shown below.

Instrument Design

The survey instrument was developed by the University Assessment and Academic Improvement Council and the individual academic departments that participated in the survey. The first part of the survey, called the 'common questions,' was given to all alumni. It included questions on current employment, continuing education, and overall satisfaction. The second part of the survey was developed by each participating department and was only given to alumni from that department. This part of the survey focused on specific aspects of alumni's degree programs. If an alumnus' degree program did not provide program-specific questions, he or she was asked 8 general questions developed by the Office of University Assessment and Testing that focused on the perceived satisfaction, effectiveness, strengths, weaknesses, and quality of his or her OSU experience. This report summarizes alumni's responses to the common questions.

Survey Administration

The survey was administered online and through telephone interviews. The Office of Institutional Research and Information Management provided alumni's email addresses and telephone numbers. The Office of University Assessment and Testing (UAT) sent three rounds of survey emails in January and conducted telephone interviews from February through May 2014. The final email reminder was sent in May 2014 and the survey administration closed in June 2014.

Results

This section summarizes results from the 2014 Survey of Alumni of Undergraduate Programs for the common questions. The Office of University Assessment & Testing performed data analyses and compiled reports. Results of department-specific survey questions were summarized in separate reports prepared for each participating department. The department-specific reports were sent to each department and are made publicly available on the University Assessment and Testing website (http://uat.okstate.edu).

Response Rate

A total of 3,149 participants responded from the target population of 7,473 alumni who graduated in either 2008 or 2012 for an overall response rate of 42.1%. Response rates for each college and degree program are summarized in Table 1. An adjusted response rate was calculated to examine the response rate when excluding those alumni who were deemed "unreachable". When accounting for "unreachable" alumni the overall adjusted response rate was 56.2%.

Current Employment Information

87.8% (n = 2709) of respondents indicated they were currently employed (CQ1). 3.4% of respondents were seeking employment. Of employed alumni, 91.5% were employed full-time (CQ4). 36.5% were employed by large corporations, 25.7% were employed with a small business or small corporation, 18.7% were employed by educational institutions, 4% were employed by the federal government, 5.1% were employed by nonprofit organizations, and 4% were self-employed. 3.6% of respondents were employed by state government, and local government (CQ3) employed 1.5%.

The most frequently reported annual salary range across one and five years post-graduation was at least \$45,000 but less than \$55,000 with 15.8% of alumni reporting this salary range. 12.6% of alumni reported an annual salary ranging from \$75,000 to \$100,000 while 6.5% reported an annual salary of more than \$100,000 (CQ7). 68.7% of alumni indicated their current position was either moderately or highly related to their degree. 92.5% of alumni reported that their undergraduate degree prepared them adequately or very well for their current position.



Continuing Education and Graduate / Professional School Information

33% of survey respondents reported they were either currently enrolled in another degree program or had already completed a subsequent degree after graduating from OSU (CQ8). Most of these respondents indicated they had either completed or were in the process of completing a Master's degree (60.5%), followed by medical (9.5%) and business degrees (7.9%). 7.1% of respondents either had competed or were currently enrolled in a doctoral program (CQ9).

Of the 920 who completed or were currently enrolled in a graduate/professional degree program and provided information, over 64% attended an institution within the state of Oklahoma. Of the 849 who provided an institution name for their graduate/professional degree program, 44.2% had enrolled in a graduate/professional degree program at Oklahoma State University.

54.5% of respondents reported that their undergraduate degree prepared them very well for continuing their education, while 38.2% indicated that they were adequately prepared for their subsequent degree program.
