2015 Survey of Alumni of Graduate Programs

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Overview

Oklahoma State University (OSU) is highly committed to excellence in academic and co-curricular programs. To that end, OSU is engaged in a continual process of assessing the strengths and weaknesses of its programs. The Office of University Assessment and Testing (UAT) conducts annual alumni surveys on a rotating schedule between alumni of graduate and undergraduate programs. Such surveys provide an opportunity to understand students' experiences as well as the perceived role of educational programs in the fulfillment of personal and career-related goals.

UAT implemented the 2015 OSU Survey of Alumni of Graduate programs to identify strengths and weaknesses as viewed by recent graduates, to track career and continuing education, and to assess student learning outcomes. Alumni surveys align with the State Regents' mandate for assessing student and alumni satisfaction. This survey was conducted from January through May of 2015 for alumni who graduated either in 2009 or 2013. UAT administered the survey both online and through telephone interviews.

This report summarizes data from a set of common questions given to all survey participants. Alumni also responded to a set of questions developed by the academic program from which they received their degree. Results for specific degree programs are provided in separate reports prepared for each academic unit. Program-specific reports can be found on the UAT website (www.uat.okstate.edu).

Response Rate

The target population for this study was 2,605 alumni and a total of 1,066 alumni completed the survey, resulting in a response rate of 40.9%. Of the 2,605 alumni in the target population, 953 alumni were considered unreachable. When adjusted for alumni for whom a valid telephone number could not be determined and alumni who could not be reached by telephone in the US, the remaining alumni for whom UAT had valid contact information was 1,652, and as such the adjusted response rate to the survey was 64.9%.

Employment

Approximately 93% of doctoral alumni and 93% of master's alumni reported current employment. Of the alumni that are unemployed, 40% of master's alumni respondents were currently seeking employment and over 63% of doctoral alumni respondents were currently seeking employment.

Of the employed respondents, about 92% of master's alumni indicated that they were employed full-time while approximately 98% of doctoral alumni reported full-time employment. Nearly 90% of respondents agreed that their graduate studies prepared them for their current position.

Alumni who reported working in a sector that was "not at all related" to their graduate studies at OSU equaled 4.7%. Most survey participants said that they worked for educational institutions (35.2%) or large corporations (30.1%). Furthermore, 15.2% of alumni worked for small businesses, while federal, state, or local governments employed 12.3% of alumni.

The salary range with the largest number of respondents was \$75,000-\$100,000 per year (21.1%). Those who reported a salary above \$100,000 per year equaled 14.9%, and 13.5% reported a salary range of \$45,000-\$55,000.



Continuing Education

Respondents who had completed, or were currently enrolled, in additional graduate programs or professional schools equaled 18.8%. Approximately 50.6% of the alumni who had attended, or were currently enrolled, in additional graduate programs or professional schools, chose OSU for this additional education. Approximately 52% of students who completed a master's degree at OSU were pursuing or had completed a doctoral degree and 24.3% were pursing or had completed an additional master's degree.

Over 87% of alumni who pursued additional education reported that their graduate programs at OSU prepared them very well or adequately for their additional education.

Satisfaction

Alumni were very satisfied with their educational experiences at OSU. 89.6% of respondents were satisfied or very satisfied with their overall educational experiences at OSU.

Community Involvement

A little more than 56% of respondents spent one or more hours per week volunteering in community groups or organizations while 42% of respondents reported no hours volunteering in a typical week. In addition, 59.5% of respondents felt very well or adequately prepared to contribute to the welfare of their communities.

Residency

Alumni living in Oklahoma who participated in the survey equaled 42.5% while 39.7% were living out-of-state. State of residency was unknown for the remaining respondents.



Methods

The target population for this survey was OSU graduate degree recipients who graduated in 2009 and 2013. This included all departments in the Colleges of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources, Arts and Sciences, Spears School of Business, Education, Engineering, Architecture and Technology, Human Sciences, and the Graduate College. The total number of alumni in the target population was 2,605. UAT conducted the survey from January through April of 2015; therefore, alumni were contacted approximately one and five years after graduating from OSU.

Instrument Design

The Assessment and Academic Improvement Council (AAIC) and the individual academic departments that participated in the survey developed the survey instrument. The first part of the survey, called the <u>common questions</u>, was given to all alumni. It included questions on current employment, continuing education, and overall satisfaction.

Each participating academic unit developed its own questions for the second part of the survey. If an academic unit did not provide specific questions, alumni were asked eight general questions developed by UAT that addressed perceived satisfaction, effectiveness, strengths, weaknesses, and quality of the OSU graduate student experience.

Survey Administration

The survey was administered online and as a telephone interview. The Office of University Assessment and Testing (UAT) sent three rounds of survey emails in January and conducted telephone interviews in February through April of 2015 with alumni who had not responded to the emails. The Office of Institutional Research and Information Management provided alumni's email addresses and telephone numbers. UAT coordinated the development of the survey instrument, conducted data collection and analysis, and prepared the reports.



Results

Response Rate

A total of 1,066 alumni completed the survey from a target population of 2,605 graduates for a response rate 40.9%. Of the target population, 953 alumni were unreachable. The absolute response rate is calculated as the number of completed surveys divided by the total number of alumni. The adjusted response rate is the number of completed surveys divided by the number of alumni who were 'reachable' (i.e. alumni who responded to a survey email or for whom we had a valid U.S. telephone number). When accounting for unreachable alumni, the overall adjusted response rate is 64.9%. The absolute response rate for each college ranged from 32.9% to 44.7%, while the adjusted response rate for each college ranged from 54.5% to 69%.

Continuing Education and Graduate / Professional School Information

About 18% (n = 194) of respondents had completed an additional graduate degree or were currently enrolled in a graduate or professional school. Of these, approximately 52% were pursuing or had completed a doctoral degree and 24.3% were pursuing or had completed an additional master's degree (Q9). Of the alumni who pursued additional education, about 53% attended OSU for an additional degree. About 87% of alumni reported that their degree program at OSU prepared them adequately or very well for their subsequent education (Q10).

Residency

Alumni who completed the survey were asked to provide their current zip code. This zip code was used to identify the state of current residence. Over 42% of survey respondents resided in Oklahoma, and more than 10% of the respondents who reported living in Oklahoma lived in Stillwater. An additional 14% of respondents lived in surrounding states, while 25% lived outside the surrounding geographic area. Approximately 18% of the respondents did not provide a valid zip code.
