2018 Survey of Alumni of Undergraduate Programs

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#### Overview

#### Response Rate

1,246 alumni responded to the survey from the target population of 7,244 undergraduate alumni who graduated either in 2012 or 2016 for an absolute response rate of 17.2%.

#### Residency

1,078 alumni provided information about their current residence location. Of these respondents, about 56.6% resided in Oklahoma, while about 28.8% resided in surrounding states (Texas, Kansas, Colorado, Missouri, Arkansas, and New Mexico).

#### **Employment**

87.5% (*n* = 1,090) of responding alumni were currently employed. Only 3.5% of the total respondents were currently seeking employment<sup>1</sup>. In June of 2018, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the state of Oklahoma was 3.9% (Bureau of Labor Statistics<sup>2</sup>, 2018). Of the employed alumni, 92.7% were employed full-time. 37.5% of those who were employed were employed by large corporations, 23.6% were employed in a small business or small corporation, and educational institutions employed 19.4%. The remaining alumni reported employment with the federal government, state government, local government, nonprofit organizations, or were self-employed. About 72.0% of alumni reported their current position was either moderately or highly related to their degree. 90.5% of alumni reported their undergraduate degree prepared them adequately or very well for their current position.

### Salary

The most frequently reported annual salary range for alumni who graduated five years ago and were employed full time was "\$75,000 but less than \$100,000" (20.6% of alumni reported this income range). The next most frequently reported salary range for alumni who graduated in 2012 was "more than \$100,000" (15.0% of alumni reported this income range). The most frequently reported annual salary range for alumni who graduated one year ago and were employed full time was "\$25,000 but less than \$35,000" (21.4% of alumni reported this income range). The next most frequently reported salary range for alumni who graduated in 2016 was "\$45,000 but less than \$55,000" (19.0% of alumni reported this income range). Overall (both 2012 and 2016), 45.5% of all survey respondents who were employed full time reported salaries of \$35,000 or greater, but less than \$65,000. 22.0% of respondents who were employed full time reported salaries less than \$35,000, and 28.9% reported salaries of \$65,000 or greater. In comparison, the average annual wage in Oklahoma in 2018 was \$43,875.00 (Oklahoma Employment Security Commission<sup>3</sup>, 2018).

#### Continuing Education

32.4% of survey respondents reported they were either currently enrolled in another degree program or had already completed a subsequent degree beyond the bachelor's degree earned at OSU. Most of these respondents indicated they had either completed or were in the process of completing a Master's degree (60.9%), followed by medical (10.9%) and doctoral degrees (7.8%). 88.9% of these alumni reported their undergraduate degree had prepared them very well or adequately for their graduate/professional degree program.

#### Overall Satisfaction

87.3% of respondents were satisfied or very satisfied with the quality of instruction at Oklahoma State University. 72.8% were satisfied or very satisfied with academic advising and a little more than 89.3% reported that they were either satisfied or very satisfied with their overall educational experience at Oklahoma State University.

#### Methods

The target population for this survey included everyone who received an undergraduate degree from OSU in 2012 or 2016; therefore, alumni were contacted approximately one and five years after graduating from OSU. The survey was conducted from January to June of 2018. The total number of alumni in the target population was 7,244. The response rates for individual degree programs are shown below.

#### Instrument Design

The survey instrument was developed by the University Assessment and Academic Improvement Council and the individual academic departments that participated in the survey. The first part of the survey, called the 'common questions,' was given to all alumni. It included questions on current employment, continuing education, and overall satisfaction. The second part of the survey was developed by each participating department and was only given to alumni from that department. This part of the survey focused on specific aspects of alumni's degree programs. If an alumnus' degree program did not provide program-specific questions, he or she was asked 8 general questions developed by the Office of University Assessment and Testing that focused on the perceived satisfaction, effectiveness, strengths, weaknesses, and quality of his or her OSU experience. This report summarizes alumni's responses to the common questions.

#### Survey Administration

The survey was administered online. The Office of Institutional Research and Information Management, along with the OSU Alumni Association provided alumni's email addresses. The Office of University Assessment and Testing (UAT) sent eight rounds of survey emails from March, 28 through June, 17, 2018.

#### Results

This section summarizes results from the 2018 Survey of Alumni of Undergraduate Programs for the common questions. The Office of University Assessment & Testing performed data analyses and compiled reports. Results of department-specific survey questions were summarized in separate reports prepared for each participating department. The department-specific reports were sent to each department and are made publicly available on the University Assessment and Testing website (http://uat.okstate.edu).

#### **Response Rate**

A total of 1.246 participants responded from the target population of 7,244 alumni who graduated in either 2012 or 2016 for an overall response rate of 17.2%. Response rates for each college and degree program are summarized in Table 1.

#### **Current Employment Information**

87.5% (n = 1090) of respondents indicated they were currently employed (CQ1). 3.5% of respondents were seeking employment. Of employed alumni, 92.7% were employed full-time (CQ4). 37.5% were employed by large corporations, 23.6% were employed with a small business or small corporation, 19.4% were employed by educational institutions, 4.0% were employed by the federal government, 7.1% were employed by nonprofit organizations, and 2.3% were self-employed. 3.3% of respondents were employed by state government, and local government (CQ3) employed 2.0%.

Overall (both 2012 and 2016), 45.5% of all survey respondents who were employed full time reported salaries of \$35,000 or greater, but less than \$65,000. 22.0% of respondents who were employed full time reported salaries less than \$35,000, and 28.9% reported salaries of \$65,000 or greater. 72.0% of alumni indicated their current position was either moderately or highly related to their degree. 90.5% of alumni reported that their undergraduate degree prepared them adequately or very well for their current position.

#### **Continuing Education and Graduate / Professional School Information**

32.4% of survey respondents reported they were either currently enrolled in another degree program or had already completed a subsequent degree after graduating from OSU (CQ10). Most of these respondents indicated they had either completed or were in the process of completing a Master's degree (60.9%), followed by medical (10.9%) and doctoral degree (7.8%). 7.0% of the alumni had either completed or were in the process of completing a Business degree.

Of the 388 who completed or were currently enrolled in a graduate/professional degree program and provided information, 42.8% attended an institution within the state of Oklahoma and 25.3% had enrolled in a graduate/professional degree program at Oklahoma State University.

52.8% of respondents reported that their undergraduate degree prepared them very well for continuing their education, while 36.1% indicated that they were adequately prepared for their subsequent degree program.
