- II. General Education: Professionalism and Ethics (PILOT '21-'22) continued discussion
 - i. Rubrics:
 - The Modified_Nicholls State University Ethical Reasoning Rubric will be used to assess Ethics pending minor revisions.
 - The Professionalism Rubric from PSS will be used to assess Professionalism.
 - ii. Process of Assessment
 - UAT will create a list of possible courses (including internships and capstone courses) that could qualify for assessment of Professionalism & Ethics and share with CAGE members.
 - CAGE college representatives will then meet with associate deans to finalize the list of courses with qualifying assignments.
 - Who to contact
 - Ethics: Instructors of courses with qualifying Ethics assignment
 - <u>Professionalism</u>: Internship supervisors and instructors of Senior Capstone courses
 - o Where and How
 - <u>Ethics</u>: Instructor permission to Canvas; UAT artifact collection; team of faculty raters conduct the review.
 - <u>Professionalism</u>: Instructors and Internship supervisors are the raters conducting the review; will submit ratings through Qualtrics via anonymous link.

iii. Next Steps:

- UAT will develop an email message to instructors which explains the needs and objectives of the 2022 General Education cycle. This will include a description of requirements/qualifications of "good" artifacts and a specific timeline.
- W. Bailey will provide a one-page summary of the existing artifact collection message.
