Discussion

- I. General Education: Professionalism and Ethics (PILOT '21-'22)
 - i. Process of Assessment:
 - External rubrics from Colorado School of Mines, Nicholls State University, and AACU were reviewed.
 - Work with instructors to collect reviews from mentors and supervisors of interning students to assess behavior-related rubrics for Professionalism. This would accompany other methods of assessment.
 - Further refinement of assessment process for the Professionalism and Ethics reviews (rubrics, course assignments, and data collection methods).
 - ii. UAT and CAGE will draft a memo to instructors of eligible courses that will communicate the objectives and needs of the General Education assessment this cycle. This message will be shared to CAGE in the December meeting for review and approval.
 - iii. Revise course list to include only undergraduate courses.
