- General Education Assessment: Diversity
 - Fall 2023 Diversity Artifact Recruitment
 - The Fall 2023 Diversity Artifact Recruitment Email Message, along with the OSU Diversity Rubric was shared. Members will send these to instructors of D, S, I, and H courses identified in the list sent last month in an effort to help encourage instructors in their college to participate in the December Gen Ed recruitment of Diversity artifacts. This recruiting period will last until the end of the semester. UAT launched its recruitment email this past Monday, December 4th.
 - Members are asked to send the letter to those faculty members who are on the list of classes identified as possibly having a Diversity assignment from their college that was sent previously. It was requested that the letters be sent out next week.
 - The use of the REVISED Campus Climate Survey for Students was approved unanimously.
 - In an effort to consider items included in the Campus Climate Survey for Students that would directly aid in the assessment of general education, while also considering the current social and political state of Oklahoma, a secondary revision of the survey was developed in collaboration with the Provost's Office. The REVISED OSU Campus Climate Survey for Students has 9 of the previous 41 items removed, leaving 32-items.
