1. Updates

- I. CAGE meetings will resume in fall beginning September 2026.
- II. Recruitment of Professionalism and Ethics is currently underway
 - i. Professionalism
 - Some instructors have indicated that completing a single Qualtrics rubric for each of their students in a mid-to large-size course would take too long. The GE Professionalism Data Collection Spreadsheet.xlsx was created to aid data collection for a large number of students. Another strategy is to collect data for a sample representative of students (~20-25%).
 - ii. CAGE members were reminded to send an email to instructors based on the Professionalism and Ethics course lists for their represented college.
- III. Responsibilities for the Summer
 - i. Recruitment efforts for collecting Professionalism ratings will again be utilized throughout the summer
 - ii. Professionalism ratings will be compiled for analysis in the fall
 - iii. Ethics artifacts collected in the Fall and Spring semesters will be reviewed by CAGE Chair (M. Bayles) and UAT representative (K. Hunger). UAT will anonymize the usable artifacts, and faculty raters will rate them over the summer.
 - iv. Compilation and analysis of results will take place in Fall 2026 and the 2026 General Education Report for Professionalism and Ethics will be ready for review in Spring 2027.
