DIVERSITY: Increase the diversity of students receiving graduate degrees and graduate certificates.

- Work with colleges and campuses to build inclusive communities for graduate students from under- represented populations to improve scholarly depth and excellence in our graduate programs as well as to increase recruitment, retention, and graduation rates.

BEST PRACTICES: Increase innovation of best practices in graduate education.

- Graduate education at Oklahoma State University is aligned with national best practices articulated by the Council of Graduate Schools (CGS). Through the Graduate College, OSU is committed to promoting excellence in graduate education and providing opportunities for graduate students and graduate faculty to excel in teaching, research, and outreach in a manner consistent with its landgrant missions.
